Treasurers Report – Cassie Thorogood

- Spring Dance proceeds were \$262.50
- Lake Hill's share of Royals ticket sales was - \$135.00
- Spirit Wear sales were \$1249.00 at a cost of \$1174.70 proceeds are \$74.30 (Sales were up a bit over previous years but costs were higher).
- Net cost of Parent Internet Safety night was \$127.50 after Education grant and Rogers Elementary contribution.
- General account: \$7,119.32 including a recent deposit and outstanding cheques. Approximately \$600 on hold for last fun lunch and \$560 reserved for Science Venture) leaving approximately \$5960.00
- Gaming account balance is \$3019.64 (with previously requested funds for the Track Meet bus \$300/iride and \$360 musical \$350 still expected to come out of gaming funds) leaving approximately \$2020.00. This was amended to \$560 for the musical.

Administration Report- Elaine McVie

- Nature playground – update, replacing trees with bigger sturdier trees at no cost, but the cost to have the organization come back is approximately \$1,500. Still working on having another picnic bench added.
- On June 23, the Rocks & Rings program will come to the school to teach students about curling and give them a chance to try it in the gym with special indoor equipment. PAC will cover the cost of about \$200.
