#### Earthquake preparedness

Cassie attended a VCPAC Emergency Preparedness presentation

A planning guide is being put together by the government

There is a representative now in place for this – she is figuring out who needs what as far as each individual school

They are working towards a list for the whole district to ask the provincial government for funding

The goal is to have all the schools be equal with the same storage container and contents

The rep would like an inventory from our school as to what we currently have in place - Elaine/Amy to provide this info

Elaine says next year this will be a big focus and would also like to get the City of Saanich involved

Cassie mentioned that the rep will be posting the presentation online – details to follow
