Kindergarten Transfer Process

Parents who wish to have their Kindergarten child attend a school other than their designated catchment school are able to apply for a transfer during Kindergarten Registration week. A transfer request application will be available upon request during registration at your catchment school. Transfer requests forms are also submitted at your catchment school.

At the end of Kindergarten Registration Week, the enrolment numbers of in-catchment students at each school are reviewed. Once all catchment students have been accommodated, transfer applications will be considered based on the Student Enrolment Priorities. Transfer applications are then approved or denied.

In the event, a school receives more transfer requests than the number of seats it can accommodate, the waitlist order of transfer requests will be determined by lottery in accordance with our student enrolment priorities.

If a student is not approved for a transfer during registration, they can apply for their second-choice school during the annual K- 12 Student Transfer process.

Inclement Weather

2) Incorporating Social and Emotional Development through the teaching of the Second Step Program.

Second Step

We are continuing school-wide with the Second Step program. Our recent focus has been helping students to become familiar with and use the strategy "Stop. Name your feeling. Calm down" when they encounter big emotions. Having students identify the emotion they are experiencing is an important first step. It is a difficult skill for children, younger ones especially. For example, if a child is having an argument with another student, they can think, or say aloud, "Stop." "I am feeling angry." "I need to calm down." Some suggested ways to calm down are to breathe (belly breathing/deep breathing), count backwards from 10 (or up to 10), and use self-talk ("It's OK." or "I can do this.") As with any skill development, the more it is practiced the better we get at it. We encourage parents to reinforce this strategy at home. Our students greatly benefit from strong home/school connections.

West Coast Recess

Just another reminder that we have a "West Coast Recess" unless the rain or wind is too much. Please be sure your child comes dressed for outside play with the colder weather. Waterproof boots are a good choice for students as the fields are muddy.

Spring Musical
