- iv. Cara attended a Special VCPAC meeting on January 29th. At this meeting she voted on three motions:
  - She voted in support of a statement that the VCPAC was to release stating that the PACs had not been provided enough time to canvass school families regarding topics discussed at the January 23rd meeting with the Minister.
  - 2. She voted in support of a motion for PAC's to bring forward the School Board draft policy 5145 Police Questioning of Students in Schools for comment from school families.
  - 3. She voted in support of a drafted VCPAC letter sharing feedback on the Proposed School District 61 Budget to be shared with the School Board.
- v. Since the meetings noted above the Minister of Education has placed a trustee to relieve the School Board trustees of their duties. All School Board meetings are cancelled and the items voted on above are not currently relevant and therefore not discussed in further detail at tonight's PAC meeting.
